N4 Road closed by angry community

The municipality regrets deeply the closing of the N4 road from Welbedacht leading to Zeerust town. The inconvenience was caused by the community that is protesting due water shortages in the Dinokana. Ramotshere Moiloa only provides water services into the following areas: Zeerust, Ikageleng and Groot Marico.

Water supply in the villages is the function of the Ngaka Modiri Molema District Municipality. However, the municipality is working together with the District Municipality and Sedibeng Water to address the issue.

Motorists and other road users using the N4 Road are urged to be cautious, patient or use alternative roads.

Furthermore, the municipality would like to apologize for power shortages in some areas around Zeerust. Those areas have been experiencing electricity shortage due to the lightning that affected the power station. The electrical department is working tirelessly to restore the electricity supply. Residents are further requested to be patient and allow the technicians to focus their energy on addressing the problem.
